Marie-Anne Dujarier is a French sociologist.

She had been working at the Sorbonne Nouvelle and at the École Polytechnique. She is now full professor at the <u>University Paris Cité</u>. She is in charge of the Master of <u>Clinical</u> <u>Sociology and Psychosociology</u>. She is a member of the Laboratory of Social and Political Change (<u>LCSP</u>) where she leads the Clinical research team.

She holds a degree in history, a Master in Work Psychology and another one in Sociology of Organizations (with M. Crozier). She earned her P.H.D in the University Denis Diderot (Paris, 2004) and her authorization to supervise research (HDR) at the University of Paris-Ouest Nanterre in 2012.

Marie-Anne Dujarier is on the **Editorial Board** of four journals (Work Organisation, Labour and Globalisation, Clinical Sociology Review, Bifurcation/s, Travailler) and member of the editorial board for a collection of books specializing in work (Octarès). She is a regular reviewer for French and international Journals.

She is invited many times a year to present her research and participate in debates with social stakeholders. Marie-Anne Dujarier is also very much involved in the dissemination of scientific information and social debate. Her work, since 2006, has been widely reported in the major French-speaking medias (press, radio broadcasts, documentaries ...).
